HIPAA Facts, and Why HIPAA Compliance is Critical

WHY
does it matter?

In 1996, the Health Information Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) was passed into law. The purpose of the law is to protect individuals’ identifiable health information, also known as Protected Health Information, or PHI.

WHO
is responsible?

Anyone, except the patient, with access to patient health information is responsible.

WHAT
if the law’s broken?

Violations can result in fines ranging from \$50,000–\$1.5 million. A HIPAA Privacy Rule infraction can also be considered a criminal act, and lead to prosecution by the Department of Justice—with jail time ranging from 1 to 10 years.
